

DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY WITH REGULATION (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR)

Subject: Conformity of packaging used by ELETTROTEC S.r.l. with the applicable requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR)

ELETTROTEC S.r.l. makes the following declaration based on verifications carried out within its supply chain, as well as declarations of conformity, technical data sheets, and attestations received from its manufacturers and suppliers and retained in its corporate records.

For packaging covered by valid PPWR documentation applicable to the specific item, ELETTROTEC has obtained evidence confirming compliance with the requirements of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 applicable as of the date of this declaration, with particular reference to the following aspects:

- Article 5 – Substances contained in packaging: the sum of the concentrations of lead (Pb), cadmium (Cd), mercury (Hg), and hexavalent chromium (Cr VI) does not exceed 100 mg/kg. Regarding PFAS requirements—where applicable based on the type and intended use of the packaging—available technical documentation confirms compliance with the limits set by the PPWR. There is no intentional use of substances that are prohibited or subject to restrictions in a manner contrary to the requirements applicable to the packaging covered by this declaration.
- Article 6 – Recyclability: the packaging is selected and managed taking into account the recyclability requirements set out in the Regulation. In particular, corrugated cardboard packaging is recyclable via paper and cardboard collection systems and is identified, where applicable, with the code PAP 20.
- Article 10 – Packaging minimization: ELETTROTEC promotes the use of packaging with weight and volume limited to what is necessary to ensure adequate levels of safety, functionality, protection, handling, and transport for the products. The application of technical minimization criteria will be updated in accordance with the delegated acts and technical specifications provided for by the Regulation.
- Article 11 – Reusability: unless expressly indicated otherwise for specific packaging solutions, the standard packaging covered by this declaration is not conceived, designed, or placed on the market as reusable packaging within the meaning of the PPWR.
- Article 12 – Labelling: material identification and labelling information are managed in accordance with applicable requirements and will be adapted to the implementing acts and relevant effective dates set out in the PPWR.

ELETTROTEC S.r.l. acts as a packaging user and verifies, within the scope of its responsibility, the documentation made available by manufacturers and other economic operators in the supply chain. This declaration does not replace the EU Declaration of Conformity which, under the PPWR, is issued by the manufacturer where required.

The conformity attested herein therefore refers to packaging for which ELETTROTEC holds suitable documentation from the manufacturer/supplier and to PPWR requirements applicable as of the date of this declaration. It does not extend to characteristics, intended uses, or subsequent processing not covered by the documentation received.

ELETTROTEC S.r.l. undertakes to keep the supporting documentation up to date and to review this declaration in the event of regulatory changes, new delegated or implementing acts, product variations, or updates to the attestations received.
